

STANDARD INTERMEDIARY CONTRACT
(for club to submit)

THIS STANDARD REPRESENTATION CONTRACT (“THE CONTRACT”) is made BETWEEN

IT IS HEREBY AGREED as follows:

1. APPOINTMENT

- a) The club requests the intermediary to:
 - negotiate with a player to conclude a player contract for the club
 - negotiate to conclude a transfer agreement for the club
- b) The club’s request to the intermediary:
 - is exclusive to the intermediary, and the club will not make the request to other intermediaries
 - is non-exclusive, and the club can make the request to other intermediaries

2. DURATION

The Contract shall take effect on and will terminate on (**Maximum 3 years**) without notice.

3. REMUNERATION

The Club shall pay to the Intermediary a commission amounting to MMK..... as a result of any employment contract negotiated or concluding transfer agreement, payable as follows:

A lump sum payment at the start of the employment contract
Annual payments at the end of each contractual year

(No remuneration will be due to the Intermediary while the Player remains a Minor).

4. TERMINATION

The Contract shall be automatically terminated with immediate effect upon the expiration of the contract. Either party may terminate this contract with immediate effect by notifying to the other party (the intermediary or the player) in writing. Nevertheless, the party who terminate the contract shall compensate for damage to the other party.

5. SUPPLEMENTAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Any other arrangements between the parties in any way connected to the provision of the services set out in the Contract shall be in accordance with the requirements of Myanmar Football Federation (MFF) Regulations on Working with Intermediaries and must be attached to the Contract and lodged with MFF together with the Contract.

6. DISPUTES

Any dispute between the parties arising out of or in connection with the Contract, including but not limited to any question regarding its existence, validity or termination, shall be referred to and finally resolved firstly by MFF Player Status Committee. Refer to art.13 of MFF Regulation on Working with Intermediaries.

7. GOVERNING LAW

The Contract and any non-contractual obligation arising out of or in connection to it are governed by and shall be construed in accordance with MFF, AFC and FIFA regulations.
