# **Stadium Ground Rules**

## **Introduction and Objective of this Monograph**

1. (a) The rules to be obeyed and practiced at this Stadium intend to elucidate and reveal the meaning for to use at the football match from the Myanmar Football Federation. It is described at these rules how to behave and stay at the Stadium in the match as for the audience and their duties and entitlements.
- (b) It will have responsibility being free from danger, security and peacefulness at ball in the match as for the Myanmar Football Federation.
- (c) The following words are used for the objectives of this rules.
  - (1) "Ticket" means a document issued materials not to bring into the stadium from the Myanmar Football Federation.
  - (2) "Prohibition" means the prohibited materials not to bring into the stadium from the Myanmar Football Federation and respective authorized organizations for to be/safe match or tend to maintain peacefulness in the ground or, to create a convenient environment for the audience coming to the ground or to implement the duties of the Myanmar Football Federation.
  - (3) "Audience" means the coming person handling the ticket for a match.
  - (4) "Inspected Implementation" means inspection using supporting materials to the materials, vehicles and individual entering into the ground security area for to be able to offer the safeguarding of the audience and concerning with participation with the match as of the ways which must be implemented at entering into the ground.
  - (5) "Bureaus which may be kept the materials temporarily" ----- places made appropriately for to be able to keep temporarily to the materials having no threatening to the health and life danger of the human beings. It will not be taken accountability form the Myanmar Football Federation for the materials not having come and piece out although exceeding the keeping time. The keeping time for the materials must not be more than (24) hours.
  - (6) "Steward" means persons called with contract from the Myanmar Football Federation for the safety, security and peacefulness of the audience within the match.

## **Notification and admitted Agreement with regard to Stadium Rules**

2. (a) Every audience coming to the Stadium must be agreed to be obeyed with reading and understanding to the special instructions issued from the Myanmar Football Federation and this rules. It may be supplied the additional ----- to this rules if required as for the Myanmar Football Federation for to be able to offer tranquility and security in the stadium to prevent clearing threatening to the health, age, and to be free from danger of those coming to the stadium.
- (b) It will be displayed with the notification advertisement signboard at the side of the stadium entrance and ticket gate to the summary of this rules as for the Myanmar Football Federation.
- (c) Guaranty will not be offered by the Myanmar Football Federation that a match will be surely held at the designated date and times as for the Myanmar Football Federation. Besides that, match holding program will have the changing right as for the Myanmar Football Federation without prior notification and will have no liability for such change.
- (d) Refunding of the ticket fees must be made as required if postponing or suspension of the match are made. It will not take the accountability as for the Myanmar Football Federation to any losses and risks such as travelling expense coming to the stadium of not having enjoyment appeared by such acting.
- (e) If conducted the prohibited implementation described at the article (6) will be made dismissing and taken action with capturing as for the audience.
- (f) Anyone who made entering to any party of the designated for to watch with staying other persons not concerning with self will be dismissed from the stadium for to have safeguarding of such person.
- (g) Utilization of the telephones are granted in the stadium and the permission granted such that is only for the performance of the personal matters.
- (h) As for the Myanmar Football Federation, it has right to dismiss from inside the stadium to anyone who may disturb or be dangerous other being presented in the stadium to that person who breached the rules.

## **Entrance Permit into the Thuwunna Stadium Premise**

3. (a) Audience will be permitted to enter into the stadium id already passed successfully to the security inspections and being free from dangers including the examination of the materials brought together and had already taken the designated ticket.

- (b) Audience require to bring along with them any document which express who he is for to be able to enter into the stadium at the day of the match.
- (c) Audience will be permitted to enter before (2) hours of (3) hours before the starting of the match or at the designated time from the Myanmar Football Federation.
- (d) Audience must be known and agreed to have entered into the designated stadium area as contained at the ticket or as of the designated stadium area as contained at the ticket or as of the designation from the Myanmar Football Federation.
- (e) The disable persons will have bringing the wheelchair into the designated stadium area for them.

### **Instruction to be followed by the audience**

4. The audience must obey the following points at the match area.
  - (a) Must be stayed maintaining not to conduct disturbing, causing dangers, and insulting other while having in the stadium.
  - (b) If there is no demarcation made in any way from the Myanmar Football Federation, audience must be entered into the stadium only from the entrance contained at the ticket and must be sit only at the designated seat.
  - (c) It must be passed inspection ways including the searching of the materials brought and inspection and searching the riding vehicle when entered with the vehicle into the stadium.
  - (d) The entrance permit documents must be shown to the authorities concerned under this rules whether entering with vehicle or entered by walking.
  - (e) The emergency exits and ladders must be used only at the requirement. The audience must be stayed refraining not to have blocking to these places. Retardation must not be made not to have causing blockage condition to the passing through to and from of the other persons when passing through form these places.
  - (f) Must not conduct to be destroyed the tranquility while being in the stadium.
  - (g) Must not conduct destroying the properties of other audience and the concerning participating persons at the match, materials owned by the public and the properties of the stadium employees in the stadium. Besides using the properties owned by the stadium respectfully and must refrain throwing the rubbish.
  - (h) Must have relationship with respect to the other audience, the responsible persons of the match and the stadium employees.
  - (i) Must be immediately informed to the respective authorities the nearest steward and the match controlling and supervising employees if appeared finding of the suspecting things,

happening an abnormal condition, catching fire, emission of smoke, and any offering of assistance concerning with medical treatment to anybody in the match.

- (j) Must be obeyed the official requests from the stewards and stadium employees and representatives from the Myanmar Football Federation within the match.
- (k) Must implemented obeying fully without causing trembling as of the respective authorities if instructed giving order to depart in emergency from within the stadium.

### **The materials prohibited to bring into the stadium**

5. The following materials are not permitted bringing into the stadium , putting in hand and using as for the audience.
- (a) Explosive materials;
  - (b) Whichever weapon including parts of weapon ammunition:
  - (c) Whichever materials knives, pointed and penetration materials, etc which may be used as weapon;
  - (d) Liquefied gas made with pressing;
  - (e) Whichever materials easily combust able and emitting sparkler of whatever shape including fireworks and gas pot used to emit smoke, fire cracker flare, etc;
  - (f) Easily combust able pieces;
  - (g) Oxidized materials and chemicals which are dangerous to the people:
  - (h) Poisonous radioactive and corrosive materials;
  - (i) Strong smell and materials which may be poisonous to the people;
  - (j) Gas and liquids which may cause the highest combustion;
  - (k) Male/Female differentiation, race, religion, colour differentiation, politics stimulation, etc whatever materials such as head band, flags, pamphlets which are arriving at the opinion of differentiation with extreme quarrelling.
  - (l) Paper rolls and Paper packages (head bands and posters which are complied with the designated requirement from this part and the Myanmar Football Federation.)
  - (m) Air-compressed musical instruments and lyric instruments (If required permission to bring must be asked submitting to the Myanmar Football Federation.)
  - (n) Body-tight garments, uniforms weared with protection at fighting, cart rig cartridge protection garments etc. utensils which may be supporting of protection to the body, some materials permitted from the doctor etc;
  - (o) Medicines such as packages packed from the original factory containing more the (7) types of medicines at one packet and medical products of the medical company (whichever from of hypodermic needle, inhalant etc) medicines (may be taken if able to

show the permit copy permitting from the doctor) That copy must be written with Myanmar or) English Language.

- (p) Medicines which are poisonous and caused mental disorder with intoxication (Must be able to show copy written in Myanmar or English language permitted to bring one number from the doctor)
- (q) Used apparatus at working.
- (r) Glass containers, glass bottles
- (s) Containers, bottles, baskets (or) plastic bags put in the liquid
- (t) Thermos flasks
- (u) Food and beverages containing the intoxicating drink.
- (v) materials contained at photo taking and video shooting (connected stick and three stick supporting shelf's)
- (w) Whichever animals
- (x) Benches which can be doled
- (y) Wheelchairs having no intention to carry the disable persons
- (z) Sport utilities including baby used moveable materials, bicycle, skate boat, etc.
- (aa) Telephones
- (bb) Flags and flag mast more greater than the length 2 meter x width 1.5 meter ( If wishing to use may be asked permission to the Myanmar Football Federation)
- (cc) Materials getting the appearance resembling advertisement used with the business objective.
- (dd) Materials which may be contacted with radio, telephone and Television.
- (ee) Whichever materials which may be filmed, recorded and broadcasted for to be broadcasted and described at the websites and social network pages for business.
- (gg) using masks, caps, other things and ways which may conceal the appearance of self except permitted from the Myanmar Football Federation.
- (hh) Umbrellas
- (ii) Drones, wind socks, gliders etc. moving an flying things.
- (jj) Whichever materials similar with the prohibited materials to bring into the stadium concerning and participating at this part.

### **Behaved implementations prohibited not to do in the stadium**

- 6. The audience must not conduct the following behaviors at the match.
  - (a) Violating the inspecting methods at entering into the stadium described at the part (3).

- (b) Entering to the place of the VIP persons, place of the medias etc, the prohibited areas from the Myanmar Football Federation, places which are not the designated area on the ticket (or) other invitation cards, etc. documents and the other prohibited area to enter.
- (c) Conducting affecting implementation to the health, danger clearance and security of anyone at the areas connected with such match and during the time of holding the sport.
- (d) Male/Female differentiation, race and religion differentiation, political stimulation, conducting the affecting behavior to other people and using excessively obscene language.
- (e) Blocking without reason to the field of vision of other or seeing the match with standing without sitting at the seat during the playing of the match will be dismissed to outside if conducted such that.
- (f) Conducting the behavior affecting the degrading of the match.
- (g) Conducting the implementation which may decrease the dignity of the match, danger clearing and security.
- (h) Smoking in the area of the match area except the designated outside the match viewing shelf to smoke cigar.
- (i) Drinking liquor in the stadium, or trying to get into the stadium with drinking may be captured from the police unit and may be hindered seeing the match.
- (j) Violating the fire danger prevention rules.
- (k) Drawing and installing advertisement or other posters and stickers on the building at the stadium premises without having permission from the Myanmar Football Federation.
- (l) Tend to damage affecting to the lavatory system, air condition system, watch distribution system, electricity connection and distribution system within the football stadium premises.
- (m) Trying to climb onto the trees, posts, fencing walls, electric posts at the Football stadium premises.
- (n) Creating to be blockages at the traffic ways in the match, or at the places such as entrance/ exit doors, ladders.
- (o) Entering into the football stadium grassland or the surrounding areas of the grassland environ.
- (p) Conducting public gathering not complying with the issued rules of the state Government.
- (q) Distributing the hand out papers and documents meaning political exhorting, differentiating male female, racial, religious, skin colour promotion advertising, promotion except the documents, photos, posters which are not affective to the other persons and exhorting the motivation to the sport teams participating the contest.

- (r) Conducting of setting fire and exploding fireworks in the football stadium area.
- (s) Implementing with behaving to be destroyed the all in one lot pushing and tranquility of the mass community.
- (t) Implementation of the destroying, burning, reverse turning, removing without having permission to the rubbish containers purposely.
- (u) Traffic driving in the football stadium area, destroying and removing of the traffic way guiding marks within other stadium, temporarily placed objects and the guiding signboard showing to be easy.
- (v) Throwing with objects to the people in the stadium and the stadium premise, persons serving the security duty, persons concerning with the sport match, other audients, stadium grassland and the surrounding of such area.
- (w) Using the self-disguising ways applying the face masks and garments having no permission from the Myanmar football Federation.
- (x) Using the noisy materials disturbing to the match players and audience except from materials used to motivate the football players.
- (y) Using with carrying the prohibited materials to being into the football ground described in the section (5).
- (z) Transmitting with recording the football match (including the hand phones using the transmitting machines for business.
- (aa) Entering into the related areas in the stadium and the premise having no permission from the Myanmar Football Federation.
- (bb) Reselling the tickets and other documents designated to enter to the holding match.
- (cc) Asking for donation within the football ground area without having permission from the Myanmar Football Federation.
- (dd) Disputed selling to the narcotize drugs.

## **Request to be obeyed by the audience**

1. As for the Myanmar Football Federation, it is trying to become a satisfied and enjoyable match being free from danger for all the audience came to encourage the present match, audience are requested not to conduct behaved implementation of the following manners.

- (a) Trying to enter without having ticket.
- (b) Denying the searching for the security.
- (c) Trying to enter to the limited prohibiting places.
- (d) Racial differentiation, political exhorting, skin colour differentiation, religious exhorting, business advertising, conducted speaking behaviors affecting other persons and handling the posters having this meaning.
- (e) Standing without sitting at the owned seat and disturbing with any way to the other audience watching while plying the football match.
- (f) Smearing at the restricted areas.
- (g) Trying to enter into the stadium with drinking.
- (h) Creating and endeavoring with any way to fall through the football match.
- (i) Throwing with materials into the stadium to the other audience.
- (j) Destroying or trying to destroy the properties in the stadium.
- (k) Video shooting made to the football match and transmitting using any media.
- (l) Re-selling the indirectly.
- (m) Selling foods or properties inside the stadium.

2. The following properties are requested not to bring into the stadium.

- (a) Explosive materials
- (b) Easily corning materials
- (c) Weapon or materials which can be used as weapon.
- (d) Poisonous materials
- (e) Posters written with words affecting other persons, business advertising, skin colour differencing, political exhorting, racial and religious differencing.
- (f) Things disturbing to others are emitting noisy sound.
- (g) Intoxicating drinks
- (h) Materials such as bottles, lasses, umbrella which may be thrown.
- (i) Radio talking machines
- (j) Materials which may be disturb other person with any mean.

3. Due to the over-encouraging of the audience, throwing things in the stadium, entering into the stadium may affect the dignity of Myanmar for being laid down to pay penalty to the Myanmar Football Federation as for the World Football Federation and the Asia football Federation.

4. Therefore, will be dismissed from inside the stadium if breaking and violating the above mentioned points and if required will be taken action under laws and it is requested to encourage as a true nationality having integrity.

Myanmar Football Federation
